Naperville, IL March 24, 2010- Registration begins April 12th at 12:01 am for the Safety Town Summer Program sponsored by Naperville Junior Woman's Club(NJWC) in conjunction with Naperville Police, Naperville Fire, Naperville Electric, Animal Control and other community groups.

Safety Town is a miniature town located at the corner of Aurora and River Roads in Naperville. It comes complete with buildings, sidewalks, streets, traffic lights, a full-size caboose, a working railroad crossing gate and Safety Town vehicles.

The Safety Town Summer Program is targeted for children entering kindergarten or first grade. Children attend a 90 minutes class once a day for an entire week. They learn from special visitors, Naperville police officers, firefighters and NJWC volunteers. Children will learn about safety related to the following: Bike Safety, Fire Safety, Proper use of helmets, Car Seat use and fit, Water Safety, Bus Safety, Pedestrian Safety, Water Safety, Electrical Safety, Train Safety, Poison Awareness, Animal Safety, Personal Safety, and calling 9-1-1. During the week-long session, their skills are reinforced through educational videos and classroom materials.

This is the 32nd year that the Safety Town Summer Program is being held. Last year, more than 1,500 children completed the one-week safety education program. Safety Town Summer Program is being held the weeks of June 7, June 14, June 21, June 28, July 12, July 19, and July 26. Classes run from 8-9:30, 10-11:30 or 12-1:30.
